This is written to you as a lot of misunderstandings happened in the matter of Mme. Haenggi and my brother Dr. H.R. Haenggi (now overseas) a short time ago, which reflected negatively on my activities and caused a lot of harm and embarrassment.

Furthermore, Mme. Haenggi has been out of the gallery business since 1976 (Madame Haenggi Gallery) and out of Gallery 101 since 1973, so I do not think that this past history should be referred to in the advertisements.
